What is the program?

WNO Young Associates gives high school students in the DC metro area who are interested in pursuing opera in college or as a career the opportunity to learn from and observe one of the world's premiere opera companies.

The program will revolve around rehearsal observation of WNO's production of *La bohème*.

- Opportunities to observe the process of creating an opera through rehearsals at various stages
- Access to WNO and Kennedy Center rehearsal and performance spaces
- Experience watching and learning about key opera repertoire
- Direct interaction with professionals in the field through discussion sessions with WNO artistic staff and the Domingo-Cafritz Young Artists

Additional events may be added throughout the school year. These would include rehearsal observations of other WNO 2014-2015 productions, as well as workshops and, for select participants, opportunities to sing for professional feedback.

Who can participate?

Students in grades 9-12 in the DC metro area who:

- Currently study classical voice at a high level,
- Show potential in classical voice if given additional learning opportunities, or
- Are genuinely interested in exploring opera or related fields as a career.

Students must be able to attend all mandatory events to participate.

When and where will the program take place?

Please see the following page for the full tentative schedule. Events will be held at the WNO rehearsal studios in Takoma Park, MD, and at the Kennedy Center.

The program will focus on the rehearsal process for one of the world's most beloved operas, *La bohème*, which will take place throughout the month of **October 2014**, with additional events held throughout the school year. Events will be held on Saturdays and occasional evenings.

What is the cost?

Application fee: \$ 6.00

Program fee: \$40.00 (includes all events)

Need-based scholarships are available.
