

# *What is Broadway Night?*

It's a musical theatre intensive where students have the opportunity to develop their skills in voice, acting, dance, and work with a variety of professional artists in the performing arts.

# *What is Broadway Night?*

- This year, we will have a virtual show.
- Students will be a part of 1 featured number + 1 full cast number
- Students will meet weekly, through google meet, with teachers & be provided learning videos to practice as well.

# What is Broadway Night?

- This year's show dates will be February 26 & 27.
- We will be finished recording for the show by mid-January so that we have enough time to produce the numbers.
- Students will be taught how to record from their homes. All they need is a school laptop, iPad or a smart phone and earbuds of some kind.

We will be working with a local TV Production company who will professionally stream our show!

There will be opportunities for students to be featured in small vocal or solo roles within their assigned numbers.

# Step 1: Choose your Vocal Audition Song

1. You will select one of the audition songs that have been created & cut for you from this link:

2. In the drive, for each song, you will find:
  - a. the AUDITION cut DEMO Track (for learning)
  - b. the AUDITION cut BACKING Track that you will record to for your video
  - c. Sheet music
  - d. YouTube Links with music & tracks combined for easy learning.

*\*You may be prompted to download materials from the drive.*

# Step 2: Review the Dance Audition

1. You will review the Dance Audition using this link:

2. If there is something you do very well (trick, flip, etc) feel free to show this in your audition video prior to doing the dance combination.
3. We just want to see how well you move so we can give you choreo that will allow you to excel.

# What we are looking for...

Intention in your choices

Attire, character, expression in the  
vocal line, energy

Precision, accuracy, evidence of  
preparation

# Ready to Record

1. Choose a well-lit space that is quiet and without distraction.
2. Use your laptop or a phone to record with.
  - a. We want to see a head to toe view of you for DANCE so a phone may be easiest to record with, in portrait mode
3. Perform Music first, dance second.
4. Slate your name, grade, what song you are singing and experience you have in vocal, acting, dance.
5. Make sure we can hear the backing tracks on the audition recording.
6. Pause the recording between vocal and dance so it all will be in 1 video for your audition.
7. Playback your video to make sure it works. 😊
